The Foundation has been busy awarding grants in this final month of the year. For many of our funds, we watch throughout the whole year for the perfect opportunity to make a grant from a particular fund. At the end of the year if we haven't awarded a grant from that fund we make a decision about the best use of money from that fund and what is best for the community. We have over 110 active funds at the Foundation and love helping meet our donors intent.

This has been an unexpectedly stressful week. For those of you who use social media, you know it is a very effective way for us to regularly communicate what is going on at the Foundation and in the Community. For those of you who don't use social media, there are various reasons you have made that decision. On Monday, we received a message that our account was suspended for breaking community standards. There was an option to appeal. Of course, feeling like we had done nothing wrong, I appealed right away, which involved a video selfie asking me to look various directions in the camera. They said I would hear back within 48 hours. The next day, I heard back that my appeal was denied and that our account was disabled for violation of community standards for fraud and deception. I am asking for your help. First, if anyone has gotten to this point with Facebook, do you have advice of how to get a help ticket so that a real person can review our case. Second, it seems that we might not be able to get our Facebook Page back. If we can't, our only option will be to create a new account. If we do this, we will need our Foundation Friends to help spread the word that we are really creating a new account and we need you be become followers of that new page.

In the meantime, this means we are unable to post for the Foundation or for Warren County Common Grounds Coffee. We apologize for this inconvenience and hope that we can figure out a solution by the end of the calendar year.

RECENT GRANTS



\$800 GRANTED FROM THE BEAU'S GIFT FUND

The Warren County Community Foundation awarded an \$800 grant from the Beau's Gift Fund to A Better Way Food Co-Op. \$1500 COMMUNITY GRANT AWARDED TO HICKMAN HEIGHTS CHRISTIAN CHURCH

The Foundation awarded a grant to Hickman Heights for the BLAST program at Williamsport Elementary School. BLAST stands for Bible. Learning. After. School. Today. On the first Thursday of each month, students can participate in after school biblically themed stations. Volunteers from Hickman Heights teach these stations including cooking, crafts, games, story time, snacks, and lessons. This group also hosts five events per year. This grant will help offset the expenses of running this program.





HUNGER FUND AWARDS GRANT TO A BETTER WAY FOOD CO-OP

The Hunger Fund is a field of interest fund at the Warren County Community Foundation. This means that a grant can be awarded to anything that fits into the area of hunger/ food insecurity, etc. A Better Way Food Co-Op is doing a great job of making food available to Warren County residents who need it. The Hunger Fund also provided \$900 of fresh vegetables late this summer and early fall. We are pleased to award this grant of \$3,750 to help the Co-Op make it through the busy holiday season.



THE DON AND MARY ANN AKERS MEMORIAL FUND AWARDS GRANT TO THE TOWN OF WILLIAMSPORT

The Warren County Community Foundation awarded a \$694 grant from this fund to go towards the new Warren County Pool. The project should begin in Spring 2025!




