AL & DOROTHY RINGER FUND AWARDS GRANT TO MAC VAN



RECENT GRANTS

The Warren County Community Foundation awards a grant for \$1.895.62 to MAC Van. MAC stands for Mobility for Area Citizens. The purpose is to provide transportation for elderly and disabled individuals in Fountain and Warren County. This includes transportation for medical appointments, to social service agencies, legal/court appointments, errands, and the pharmacy. MAC is a demandresponse transportation program, which means each day is scheduled according to the number of requests, times, and locations of appointments. Eligibility includes individuals age 60 and older, handicapped, Medicaid recipients with transportation to medical appointments.

RAY AND HAZEL BARWICK FUND AWARDS GRANT

The Warren County Community Foundation also made a grant for \$536.18 from the Ray and Hazel Barwick MAC Van fund. We are pleased to have these two great funds that provide annual assistance to the MAC van program.

GEORGE AND KATHERINE RECTOR FUND AWARDS GRANT


This designated fund has an annual payout that goes to Hanging Rock. The award this year was \$2,942. The project the fund paid towards this year was the architectural plans for a handicapped accessible cabin. Hanging Rock received a grant from the Wheeler Foundation that will cover the cost of building the cabin, but for all of the permitting, an architectural plan was also necessary. We are happy to play a very small role in this large project.



the evening will go to the Legacy Builders Fund. The annual grants from this fund are awarded at the event. Three organizations will be selected by the committee. Half-way








A BETTER WAY FOOD CO-OP GEARS UP FOR BRACKETS TO BENEFIT OTHERS
