Hello Foundation Friends,

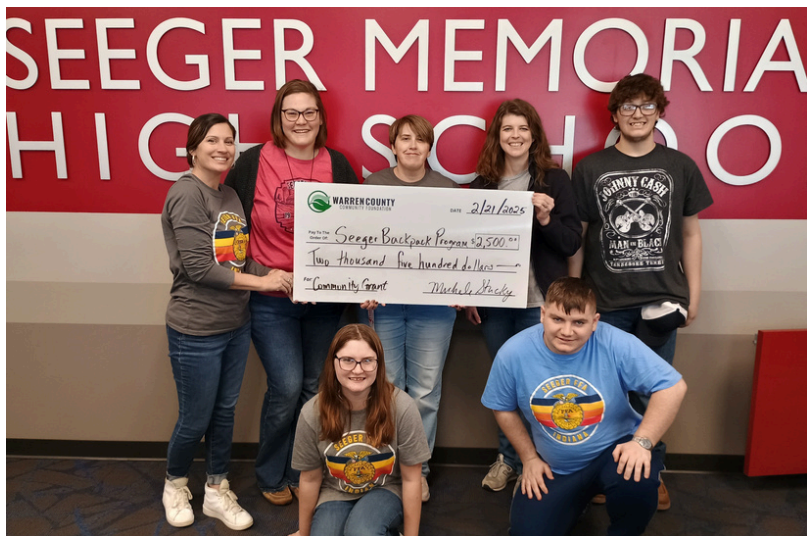

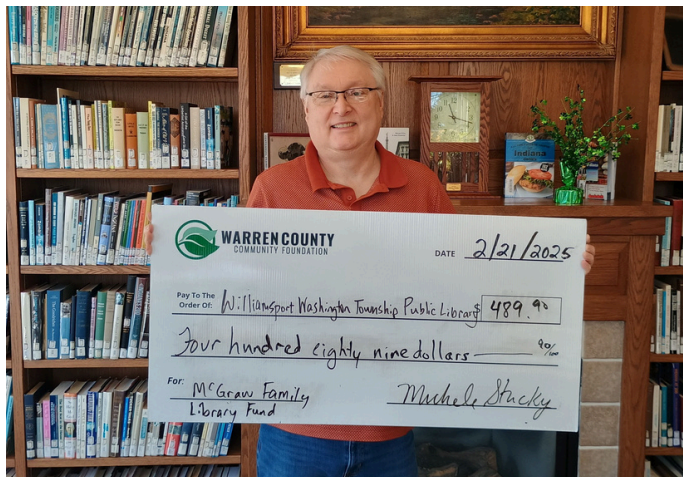

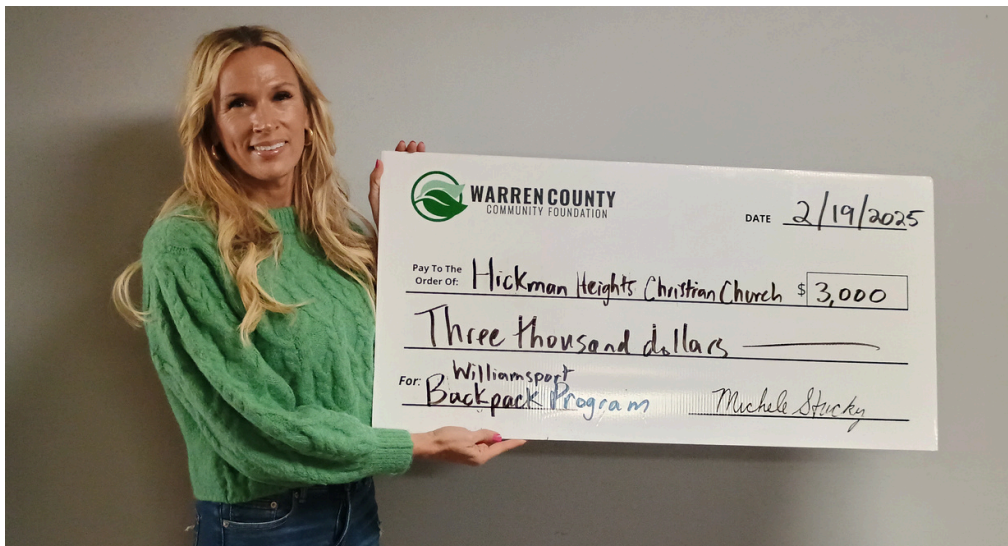
TWO DESIGNATED FUNDS AWARDED TO WILLIAMSPORT WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP PUBLIC LIBRARY

The Warren County Community Foundation has two designated funds with the library being the beneficiary. The George and Carolyn Paulson Library Fund awarded a grant in the amount of \$610.79. The McGraw Family Library Fund awarded \$489.90 this year. Designated Funds are a great way to make sure that whatever organization you are most passionate about is the one that receives the grant annually. When a designated fund is set up, the donor chooses the purpose and recipient. The donation is invested in a balance towards growth investment portfolio. Each year a percentage of that balance is awarded as a grant to the organization.



ALFRED AND DOROTHY RINGER SENIOR CENTER FUND AWARDS GRANT

The Warren County Community Foundation awarded a grant from the Alfred and Dorothy Ringer Senior Center Fund in the amount of \$791.09. The Williamsport-Attica Senior Center can use this to put towards their programming or items they need.



COMMUNITY GRANT AWARDED TO HICKMAN HEIGHTS CHRISTIAN CHURCH

Hickman Heights Christian Church runs the backpack Program for Williamsport Elementary School. They hosted a Bingo night to raise money to purchase all of the food items that go inside the backpacks that go home weekly with students in need. The Foundation agreed to match proceeds brought in that night from the Bingo, raffle, purchase of extra cards, and silent auction up to \$3,000. The event was a success and we are pleased to be able to match 3,000 of the dollars that came in that evening.
