RECENT GRANTS



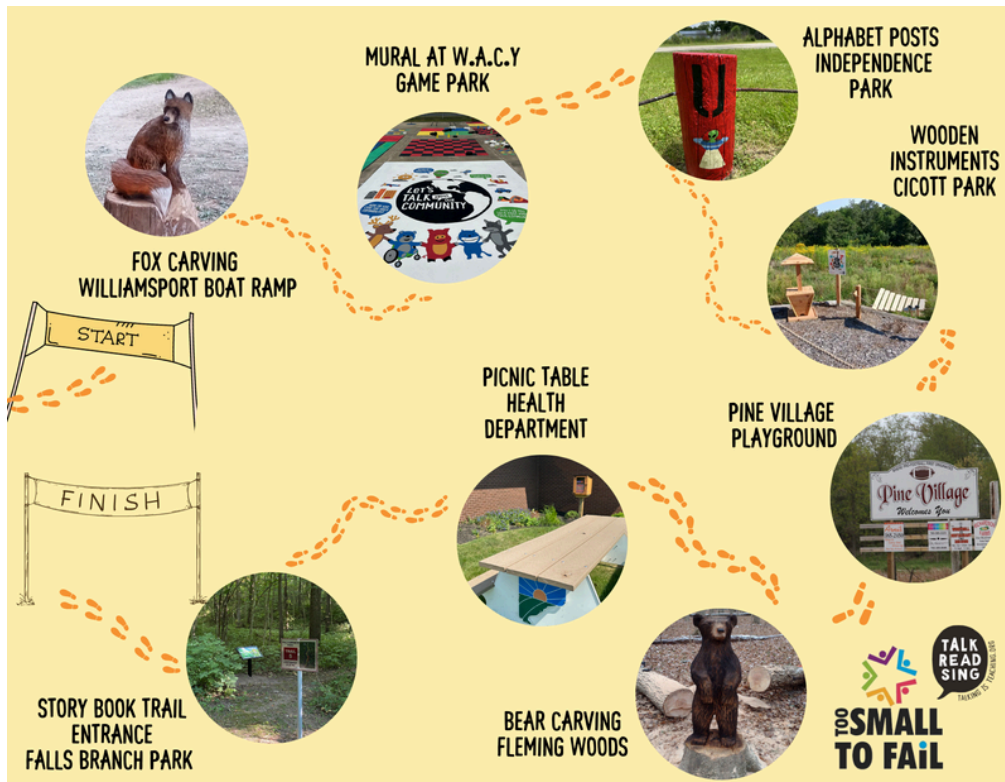
COMMUNITY GRANT AWARDED TO POTAWATOMI SPRINGS


